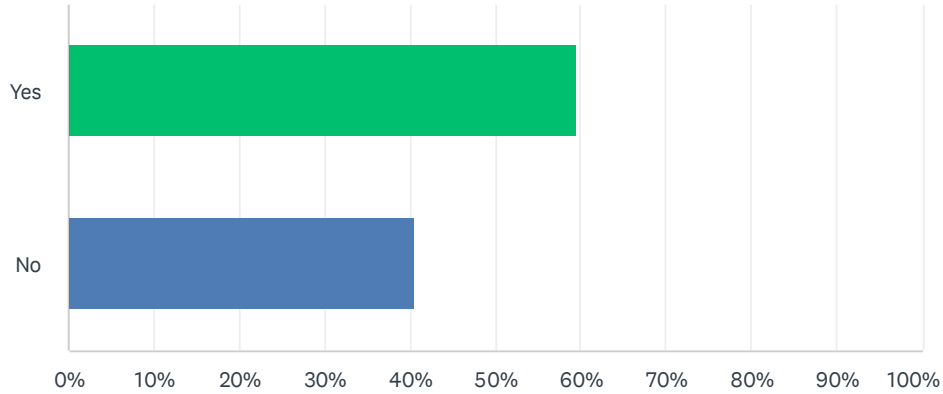


# Q1 In your practice or organization are your mid-level providers given paid time off in the same manner as non-physician staff?
